While the ideas discussed aren't always the most intuitive and the assignments very difficult, the professor makes a great effort to talk students through ideas behind the problems so they develop an understanding.

I think Dr. Cioaba is an excellent teacher; I took MATH688 with him previously, and enjoyed this course even more. I greatly appreciated the help on proof sets, as he was always willing to give hints to the general direction we should take with problems we were struggling with. His explanations to any questions I had were always clear, and quite helpful. The only comment I really have is about the speed of his handwriting- I wasn't always able to keep up with how quickly he wrote, and so every once and a while I had to leave off material. That could be on me, as it may be that I needed to learn how to filter what should be written better than I have been.

Dr. Cioaba was a great teacher. He did a good job of covering a range of material throughout the course and always made additional papers and resources available to us if we wanted to learn more. I especially appreciate the variety of topics we saw, and I believe it was helpful in finding what I am interested in. During lecture, drawing pictures and using small graphs to demonstrate a larger idea throughout a proof was a great way to help me follow along. Additionally, color-coding throughout proofs and examples made a positive difference.
