¹ Beginning in 2014, the methodology and results reflect National Association of Colleges and Employers (NACE) standards. The response rate is actually a "knowledge rate" which includes all available data collected.

² The number in class is based on expected graduates from IPEDS degree completions data.

³ The number of respondents includes baccalaureate respondents with valid data on Career Plans Survey "Post-graduation status" question, along with additional data collected toward the "knowledge rate".

⁴ Results at the University Total level for all baccalaureates are unduplicated based on graduates' 1st Major. Thirty-one (0.9%) of the 3,600 respondents indicated that they are participating in a volunteer or service program (e.g. Peace Corps), twenty-four (0.7%) of the 3,600 respondents indicated they are engaged in military service, fifty-eight (1.6%) of the 3,600 respondents indicated that they are planning to continue education but are not yet enrolled, and ten (0.3%) of the 3,600 respondents indicated they are not seeking work or further education in 2019.

⁵ Results within each College/Portfolio level are unduplicated. Where a student had majors in more than one college (or portfolio in Arts & Sciences), they are counted in each accordingly.
