Entering Freshman Cohorts 2007 through 2010
Executive Summary**

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Methodology

This retention study covered entering freshman cohorts at the University of Delaware for fall 2007 through fall 2010. All analyses were done for first-time full-time freshmen for the Newark campus and the Associate in Arts (AA) program, broken down by either college or campus where appropriate. This study examined first to second year retention rates and then compared mean SAT total scores (reading and math) and mean GPAs of students by their retention status. Please note that for the purpose of personal information protection, mean SAT total scores and mean GPAs are not reported if the number of students in a group is less than 3.

The first part of this study assessed overall retention of Newark campus freshmen. Students were divided into three retention status categories: “retained in the same college”, “retained in a different college”, and “not retained”. The determination of whether a student is retained in the same college is based on the student’s home department. In other words, if the student stays in the same department in the second fall, he/she is classified as “retained in the same college” even though the department may have moved to a different college. All comparisons were made based on these three categories.

The second part of this study examined the retention of Newark campus African-American and Hispanic freshmen, respectively. Retention rates were calculated based on whether a student is retained or not by the second fall and then comparisons of SAT total scores and GPAs were made by their retention status. For each ethnic group, all results were further broken down by gender.

Lastly, this study looked at the retention of Associate in Arts program freshmen. Retention rates were calculated based on whether a student is retained or not by the second fall. Comparisons of mean SAT total scores and mean GPAs were then made between retained students and non-retained students.

Major Findings

With regard to the 2007-2010 Newark campus cohorts, this study has found that the retention rates for African-American freshmen were consistently slightly lower than the overall retention rates for all first-time full-time freshmen. The pattern of retention for Hispanic students was essentially the same as that of all Newark campus freshmen among the 2007 and 2008 cohorts. However, the retention rates of

the 2009 and 2010 Hispanic cohorts had fallen slightly and were lower than the overall retention rates during the same period. Among all Newark campus freshmen, retained students consistently had higher average SAT total scores and higher average GPAs compared with those who were not retained. The same pattern can be found among Newark campus Hispanic students. The findings for African American students are less clear-cut. Retained African American students had higher average GPAs than their peers who were not retained in all four cohorts. However, when looking at the 2010 cohort, the average SAT total scores of African American freshmen were virtually the same regardless of retention status. The average SAT scores of retained African American freshmen were actually lower than their counterparts in previous cohorts.

This study has also yielded mixed findings regarding the 2007-2010 AA freshman cohorts. Retained AA students in all four cohorts had higher average GPAs than their peers who were not retained. With the exception of the 2009 cohort, retained AA students actually had lower average SAT combined scores than those in “not retained” category.
