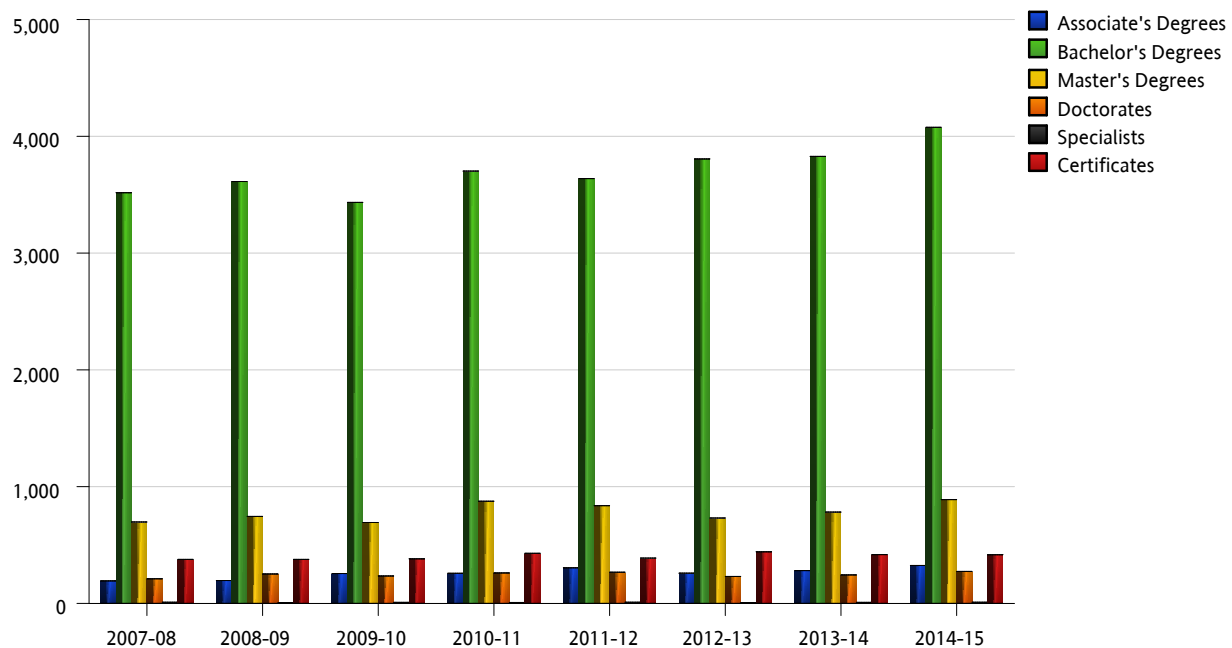

NOTE: Graduation terms defined by federal IPEDS standards (July 1 through June 30). Since some graduates earn degrees across different colleges (eg. AS-BS, AG-BS), the sum of degree counts across colleges may be greater than the degree distinct total at each degree level. Also because one student can earn multiple degrees (eg. AS-BA, EG-BS), the sum of degree distinct totals may be greater than the number of students who graduated.
