# INTENSIVE ENGLISH PROGRAM



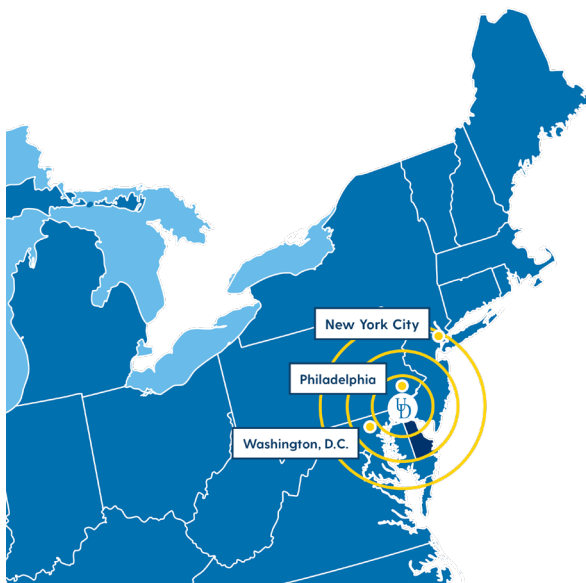
IEP is a full-service English as a Second Language (ESL) program that helps general language learners improve their English skills and business professionals learn English for career enhancement.

## REQUIREMENTS

- All adults seeking to improve their English proficiency can participate.
- Must be a high school graduate and at least 17 years of age.
- No minimum English level or score is required.

## PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- **6 levels of instruction** (beginner to advanced) based on proficiency. Each level takes 2 months to complete.
- **4 tracks of study:** Business, Academic, American Culture, General English.  
*\*Some tracks are dependent on sufficient enrollment numbers.*
- Listening/Speaking and Reading/Writing courses at all levels.
- **1:1 Tutoring Center** with experienced, professional tutors to address students' personal learning difficulties. We are the only IEP in the U.S. to offer this resource.
- **Rich cultural trips** to Washington D.C. or NYC.
- **Robust cultural program**, which includes 4-5 on-campus activities every week. We are one of the only IEPs in the U.S. to offer this level of engagement. Example activities: guitar club, movie nights, holiday parties, women's club, cooking lessons, and more! Bonus opportunities to practice English at our learning HUB, including: Writing Table, Book Club, Conversation Couch, Walk-In Tutoring, Self-directed Study, and more!
- **Live with a host family** for full immersion or stay in our off-campus housing facilities.
