Academic Transitions (AT) is UD's own pathway program for conditionally-admitted undergraduate international students. As an AT student, you will enroll in university courses while improving your academic English skills, following a special track of study with courses and credits that count toward your bachelor's degree at UD. You can earn up to 28 credits while studying on campus at the ELI-almost the equivalent of the first year of university—which helps you finish your UD degree in 4 years! AT gives you access to all UD majors.
