## Invest in Your Future

Academic Transitions (AT) is UD's own pathway program for conditionally-admitted undergraduate international students. As an AT student, you will enroll in university courses while improving your academic English skills, following a special track of study with courses and credits that count toward your bachelor's degree at UD. You can earn up to 28 credits while studying on campus at the ELI—almost the equivalent of the first year of university—which helps you finish your UD degree in 4 years! AT gives you access to all UD majors.
