Banners: Individual members of 4-H clubs are encouraged to design and display a 4-H banner in the community.

Rules:

- Displays must be in place by 5:00pm Sunday, Oct. 1 and remain displayed until 5:00pm , Saturday, Oct. 7.
- Window displays can be a maximum of 7' x 30"
- Banner must be 2' x 3' in dimension

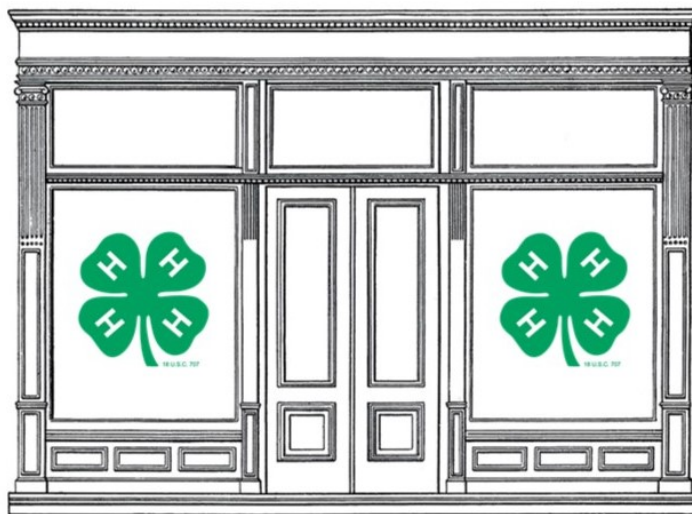
