- The NCC 4-H Demonstration Contest will be held in two sessions: April 10 and May 8. Kaitlin reminded everyone about the 4-H Demonstration Script starter idea that club leaders can share with their 4-Hers to help them develop their demo.

- All Delaware State Fair youth Livestock exhibitors photos are due to the State Fair by July 1. These will be used if the exhibitor makes the Livestock Auction.
- The NCC Leader's Association will once again staff the Delaware Farm Bureau food booth at the Delaware State Fair on the first Saturday of the Fair (July 19) from 3pm until close.
