This time we'll be talking about *Varroa* mites. Learn about this significant pest, how to check levels in your colonies, and review some different treatment options

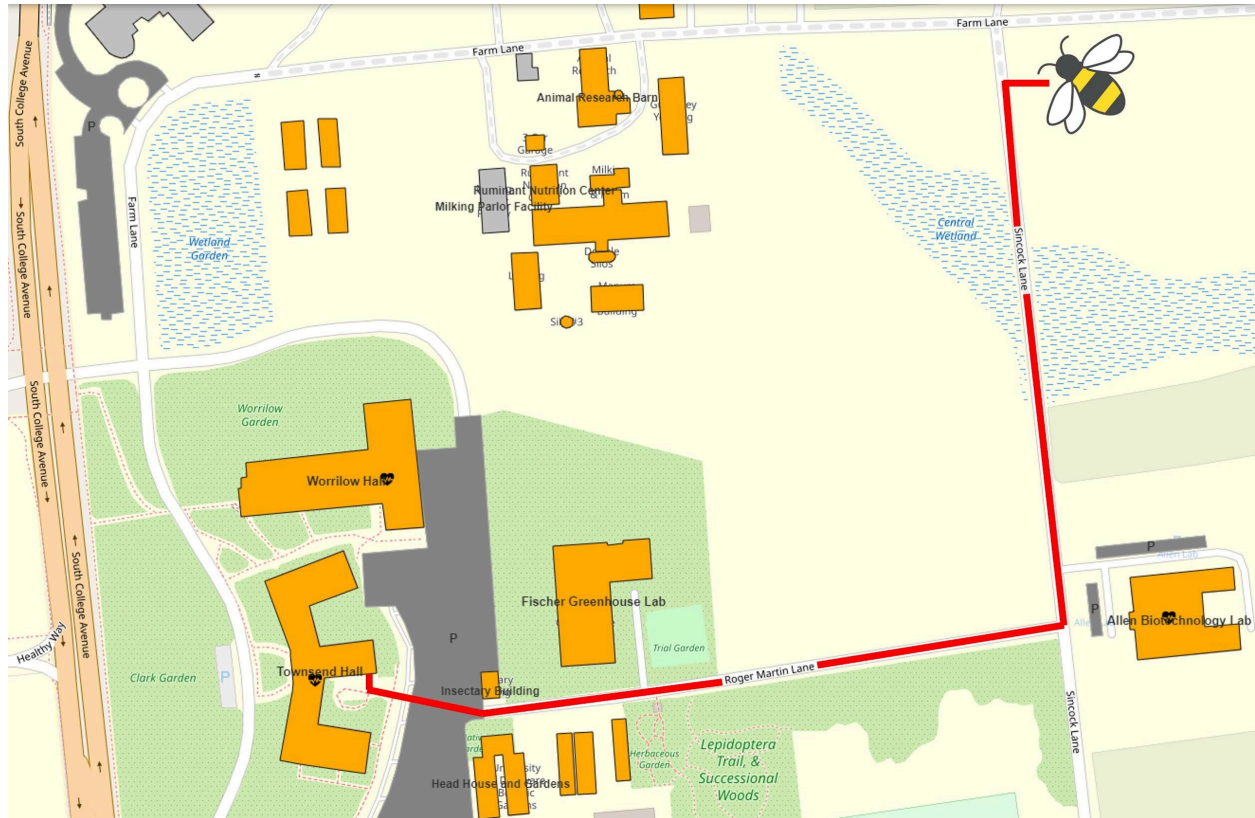
Note the new start time. As days get hotter, we start earlier!
