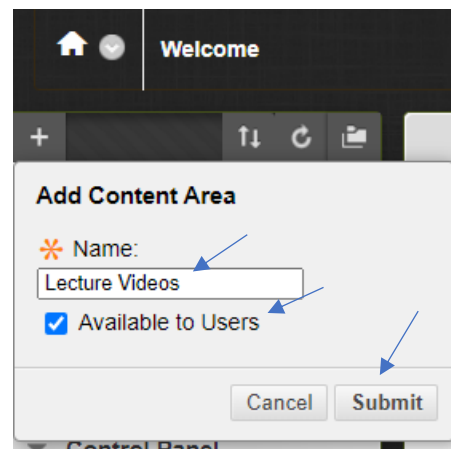
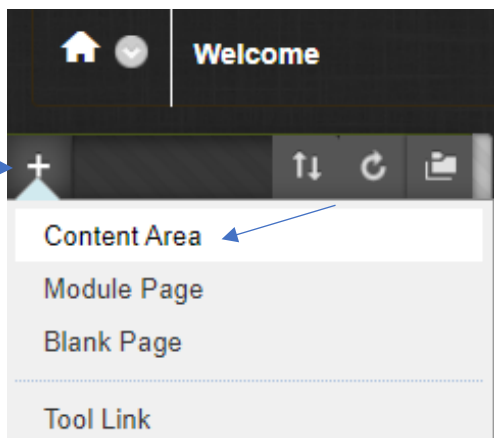


## ECHO360

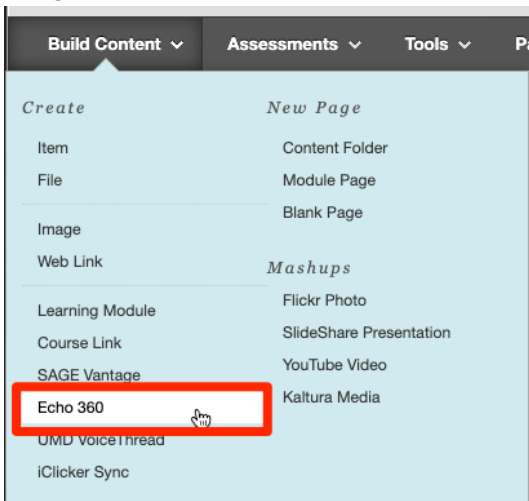
How to add Echo360 to a course in myCourses and link to your lectures

**Step 1.** Navigate to your course in myCourses.

**Step 2.** Add a Content area to your menu by clicking on the + sign, selecting “Content Area”, type in Lecture Videos, select “Available to Users” and click “Submit”.



**Step 3.** Click on “Lecture Videos”, then click “Build Content” and then choose “Echo 360”.



**Step 4.** Insert a Name into the “Name” field. Then click “Submit”.

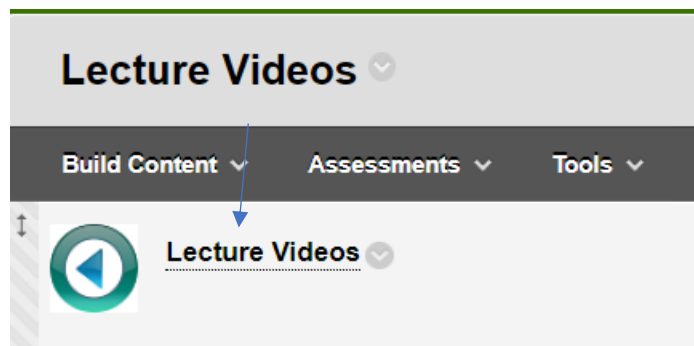

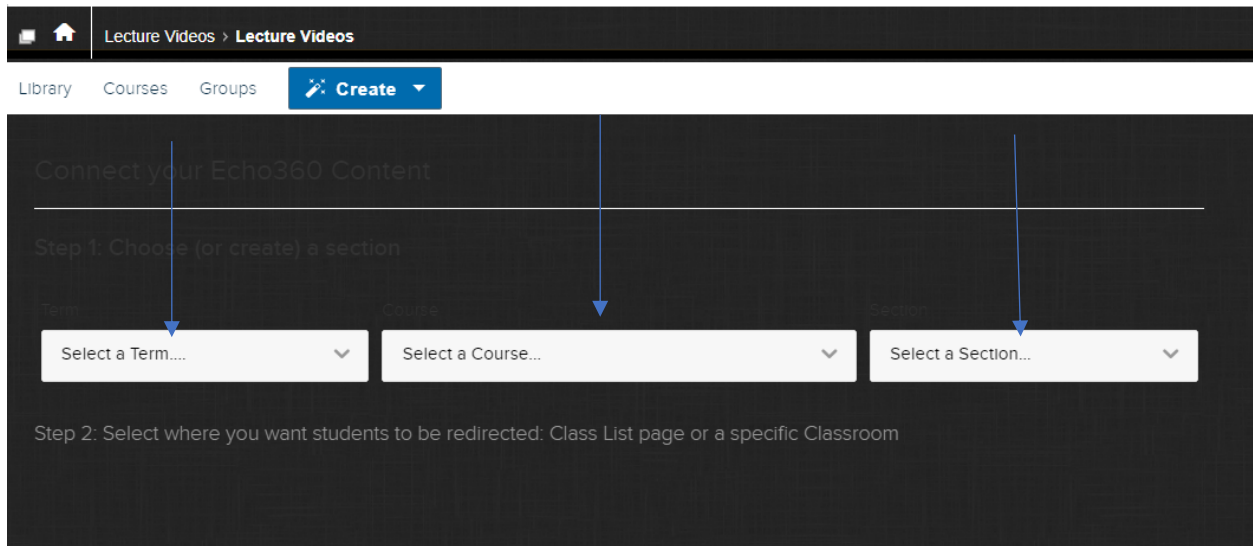
**GRADING**

**Step 5.** You have now created a link to ECHO360. Now you need to indicate which class you would like to link to in ECHO360. Click on the link.

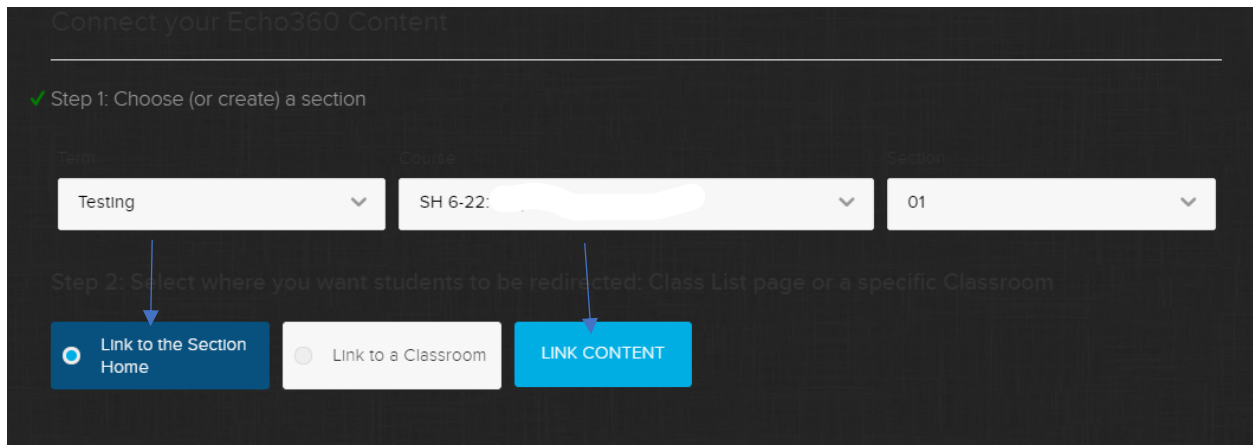


**Step 6.** Select the Term, Course and Section you would like the students to view.



*Please note:* You cannot link to a course in a past term as student access expires after a term is over. If you need to reuse content from a previous term, please request a new section be made for the current term and copy over the content.

**Step 7.** Once the proper course is selected, ensure the “Link to the Section Home” is selected and then click “Link to Content”.



**Step 8.** Your students now have access to the recordings.



As a reminder, you do not need to do anything special when in the room, recording starts automatically. Also, ensure the Vol Mute button on the podium is not illuminated; when the speakers are muted, so are the microphones.
