3. <u>Growing With Canvas</u> Canvas has created a very helpful training course to introduce you to their Learning Management System (LMS). We strongly encourage you to complete this training before designing your courses in Canvas.	9. ID Newsletter  Twice a month, ID sends a newsletter to all faculty with information on the latest teaching trends as well as tips on using Canvas and other instructional technologies. Look for the latest newsletter in your email and use the link to browse past newsletters.
4. Vendor Led Vault  This is a collection of instructional technology vendor-led training demonstrations. These training courses are pre-recorded and intended to be self-paced; following completion of the Growing with Canvas course. We invite you to check back often, as new vendor training will be added throughout the year.	10. ID Workshop and Offerings Throughout the year, ID offers workshops and training to support your teaching at UMassD. We offer everything from 4-week pedagogy training to 60-minute sessions on using Microsoft programs and navigating Canvas.
