**Motion** to file a grievance for requiring anything but the 16a, as shown in the contract, such as expanded 16a, and a C.V., to be eligible for satisfactory evaluation and to be eligible for across the board raises

Motion passed by the affirmative vote of 14 Present and voting members; 0 No; 0 Abstain.

**Motion** that the MSP Board supports the process for Mediation for the Brown Case on Course compensation.

Motion passed by the affirmative vote of 13 present and voting members.; 0 No, 0 Abstain.

**Motion** that the MSP Board file a level 2 grievance regarding Associate Dean Richard Serna's refusal to permit College of Education Chair James Nehring to assign overload courses to faculty who are willing to teach them. The chair of the Economics Department was also instructed by the Dean's office to deny willing faculty overloads courses.

Motion passed by the affirmative vote of 10 present and voting members.
