## WIDENER UNIVERSITY STUDENT CO-OP AGREEMENT

The Cooperative Education Program (Co-op), facilitated by the Career Design and Development staff at Widener University is an academically-based optional program that assists participating students in identifying appropriate, qualified positions. In addition to my compliance with all Widener University policies and procedures, as a student enrolled in the Cooperative Education Program, I agree to the following (please initial each section):

1.	I understand that a co-op position is a full-time (minimum of 32 hours a week) work experience during an academic term.
2.	I understand that the University does not guarantee a co-op position, nor does it assign a student to a specific co-op position. Students are ultimately responsible for obtaining a position for the Co-op Program
3.	I must participate actively with the Career Services staff throughout the entire process, including the following guidelines:  a. Check Widener email daily  b. Respond to requests within 48 hours  c. Participate in all Co-op requirements

- 4. I will be bound by all co-op policies and procedures outlined in the Co-op Student Handbook and as follows:
  - a. Attend a Co-op Orientation and sign student agreement (if this first step is not completed, you will not be granted access to the program.) Returning co-op students are not required to attend another orientation but are required to sign co-op student agreement
  - b. Commit to the program by the designated deadline by completing the commitment survey
  - c. Maintain 2.5 GPA or above by the end of the spring semester immediately preceding the chosen Co-op term
  - d. Complete a mock interview during the designated time frame
  - e. Make all recommended resume changes until final approval by Co-op advisor in order for resume to be shared with employers
  - f. Attend all summer professional etiquette workshops (OC 150) and complete corresponding course assignments (first time Co-op students only)
  - g. Learn about all on-campus responsibilities in advance, including leadership and RA requirements and responsibilities, and plan accordingly
  - h. Submit Co-op reflection paper and attend reflection session

I understand that failure to follow these pol	cies or procedures ma	ny result in dismissal from
the program and/or receiving a Did Not Co.	nplete designation on	my academic transcript.

5.	I understand that I must be a full-time student and maintain an overall grade point average of at least 2.50. I must also be in good academic standing and follow appropriate Academic Progress guidelines found online under the current Undergraduate Catalog
6.	I understand that I must meet academic credit minimum and maximum levels, outlined in the Co-op Student Handbook, prior to seeking a position for a given co-op term
7.	I have the right to appeal grading decisions made by the Director of Career Services to the Associate Provost for Undergraduate Academic Affairs.
8.	I understand that it is my responsibility to investigate fully any potential employer. Final acceptance of a position, including all terms and conditions proposed by the employer, is my decision
9.	Widener's Career Services staff may act on my behalf with prospective and current Cooperative Education employers to share information about me, as reasonably related to the Co-op hiring process, my performance once hired as a co-op employee, or my separation from Co-op employment. I hereby release Widener University, its trustees, officers, employees and agents, and my prospective, current and former employers from any and all claims, liability and damages arising from the exchange of such information
10	. My acceptance of a Co-op position constitutes a contract with the hiring organization for the agreed upon terms and conditions of the position. I understand that I may not rescind my acceptance of an offer nor continue to interview with other positions after accepting this offer
11	. I will contact my career counselor if any aspects of the position change that are inconsistent with the agreed upon terms and conditions or if the duties or environment become detrimental to my mental or physical well being
12	. I am subject to all employment policies, procedures, and schedules established by the employer. Termination of a Co-op by an employer for reasons relating to my performance or non-performance of job duties and/or related issues may result in a Did Not Complete grade being given to me for that Co-op. I must immediately notify my career counselor of any change in employment status
13	During the term of my employment by the Co-op employer, I shall be considered a full-time employee of the employer and shall be subject to coverage under applicable workers' compensation laws of the state in which the place of employment is located. Employers' liability to students for accident or injury on the job may be limited by the applicable employment. Students are advised to familiarize themselves with such workers' compensation laws and their rights
