



4-Month CO-OP SCHEDULE

Planning for the fall cycle

1

1 year in advance (fall semester):

Advertisements for fall co-op orientation sessions will be released to eligible students a full calendar year in advance.

3

8 months in advance:

Students commit to the co-op program by completing a commitment survey provided by CDD staff. Deadline typically falls in mid-late January.

2

10–11 months in advance:

Orientation sessions will be held throughout the fall semester by Career Design and Development (CDD) staff. To commit to the co-op program, students must attend one session.



4

4 months in advance:

Students schedule summer courses and enter co-op during the fall semester.

5

Start of fall semester:

Co-op begins.

Eligible students attend orientation in their freshman or sophomore year and go on co-op in their sophomore or junior year. Computer Science/Computer Information Systems students are eligible to participate in their junior year and should begin the planning process in their sophomore year.

1

1 year in advance (spring semester):

Advertisements for spring co-op orientation sessions will be released to eligible students a full calendar in advance.

3

10 months in advance:

Students commit to the co-op program by completing a commitment survey provided by CDD staff. Deadline typically falls in mid-late March.

2

10–11 months in advance:

Orientation sessions will be held throughout the spring semester by Career Design and Development (CDD) staff. To commit to the co-op program, students must attend one session (if they have not yet participated in a past co-op cycle).

4

9 months in advance:

Students schedule summer and fall courses and enter co-op during the spring semester of their junior year.

Eligible students attend orientation in their sophomore year and go on co-op in their junior year.
