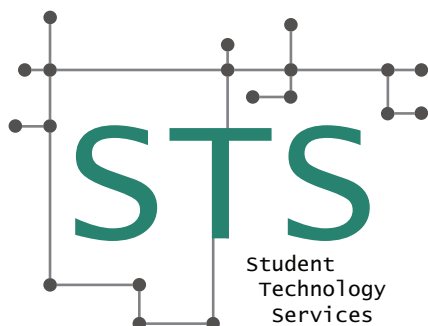

STS SHOWCASING NEW TECHNOLOGY AT OLIN LIBRARY'S TASTE OF TECHNOLOGY FAIR

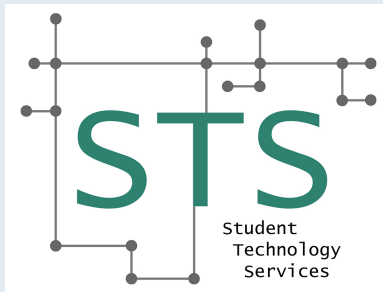
Student Technology Services participated in the Taste of Technology fair organized by Olin Library and promoted the WUSTL Mobile App and print@wustl.edu.
