

Individuals who have a BJC-NT ID, HRPO ID, or Limited Access ID and completed the CITI Human Subject Education Training using a WUSTL Key associated with a Guest WUSTL ID or a past non-employee ID will need to enter their CITI ID into their myIRB profile. *The following directions do not apply to WUSTL employees/students OR individuals who completed CITI through another institution.*

To find the CITI completion ID and enter it in the myIRB system...

1. Obtain a copy of your CITI Completion report.

Note: If you do not have a copy of your CITI completion report, HRPO does not provide copies. Go to <https://research.wustl.edu/citi/> to access the CITI Program Quick Guide. Refer to the section "Accessing Your Completion Records" to obtain a copy of your report.

2. Typically, the number appears on the report as the "Reference ID" or the "Report ID". Use the following images to help locate the number you need.
