

E. Desmond Lee Concert Hall

This traditional auditorium space provides 1,092 seats on a single gently sloped level and features a partial-thrust stage that can accommodate performances from solo recitals to full orchestra concerts.

Entrance is via Trinity Ave Lobby (wheelchair accessible) and Delmar Blvd Lobby.


