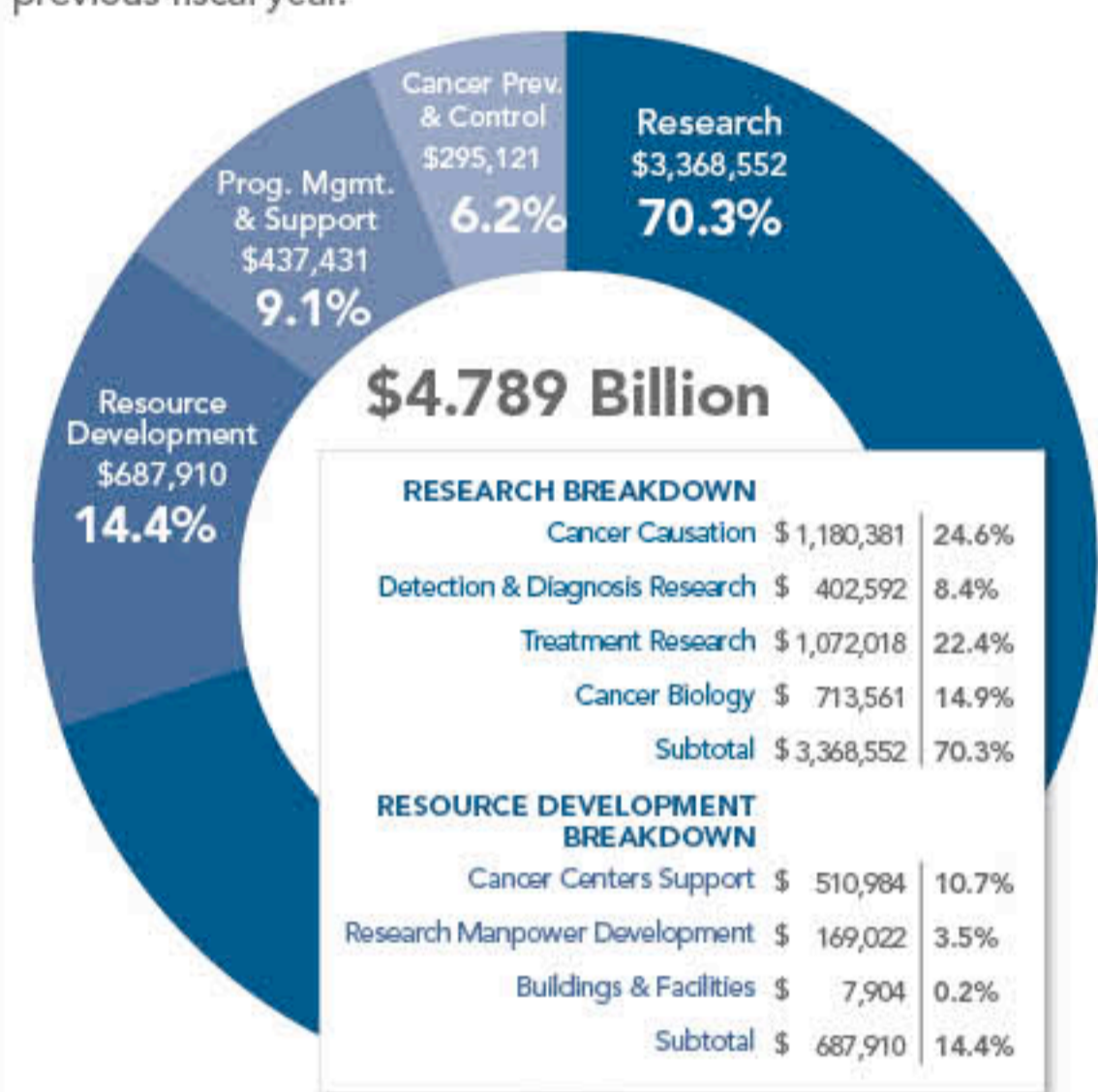
SCOPE OF OUR WORK



NCI OVERALL BUDGET: FY 2013

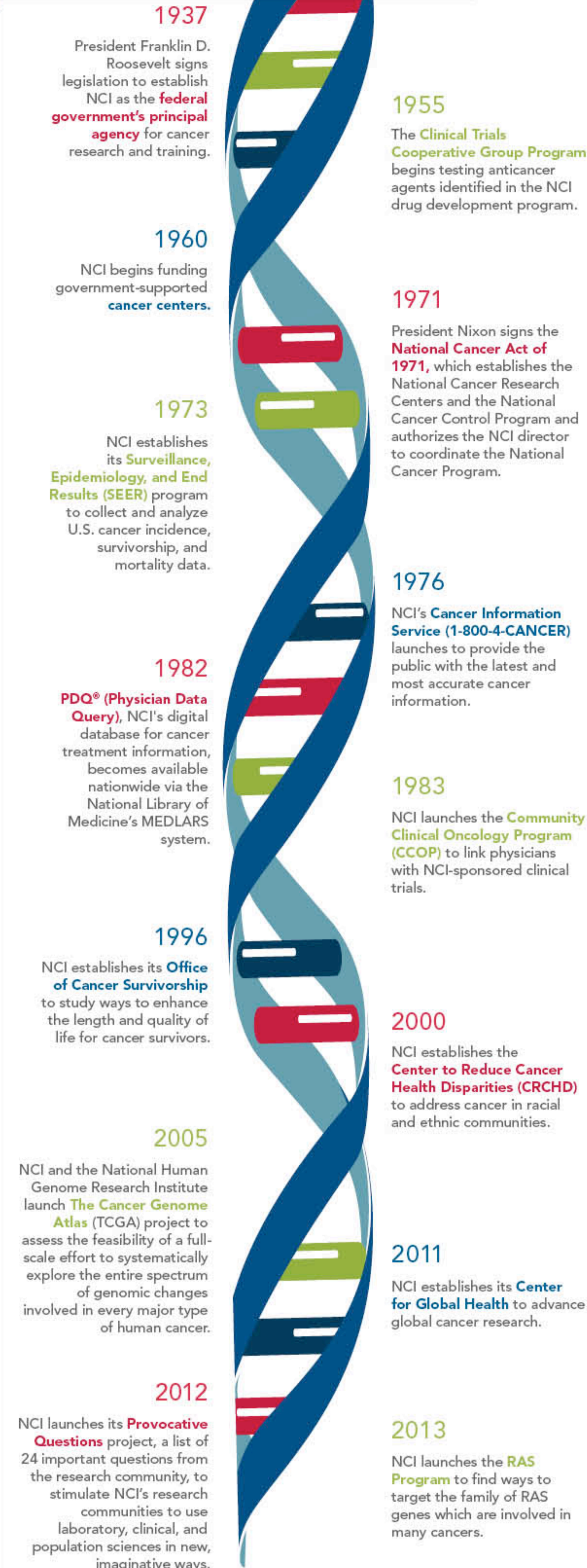
(Dollars in thousands)

Funds available to the NCI in FY 2013 totaled \$4.789 billion*, reflecting a decrease of 5.5%, or \$278 million from the previous fiscal year.



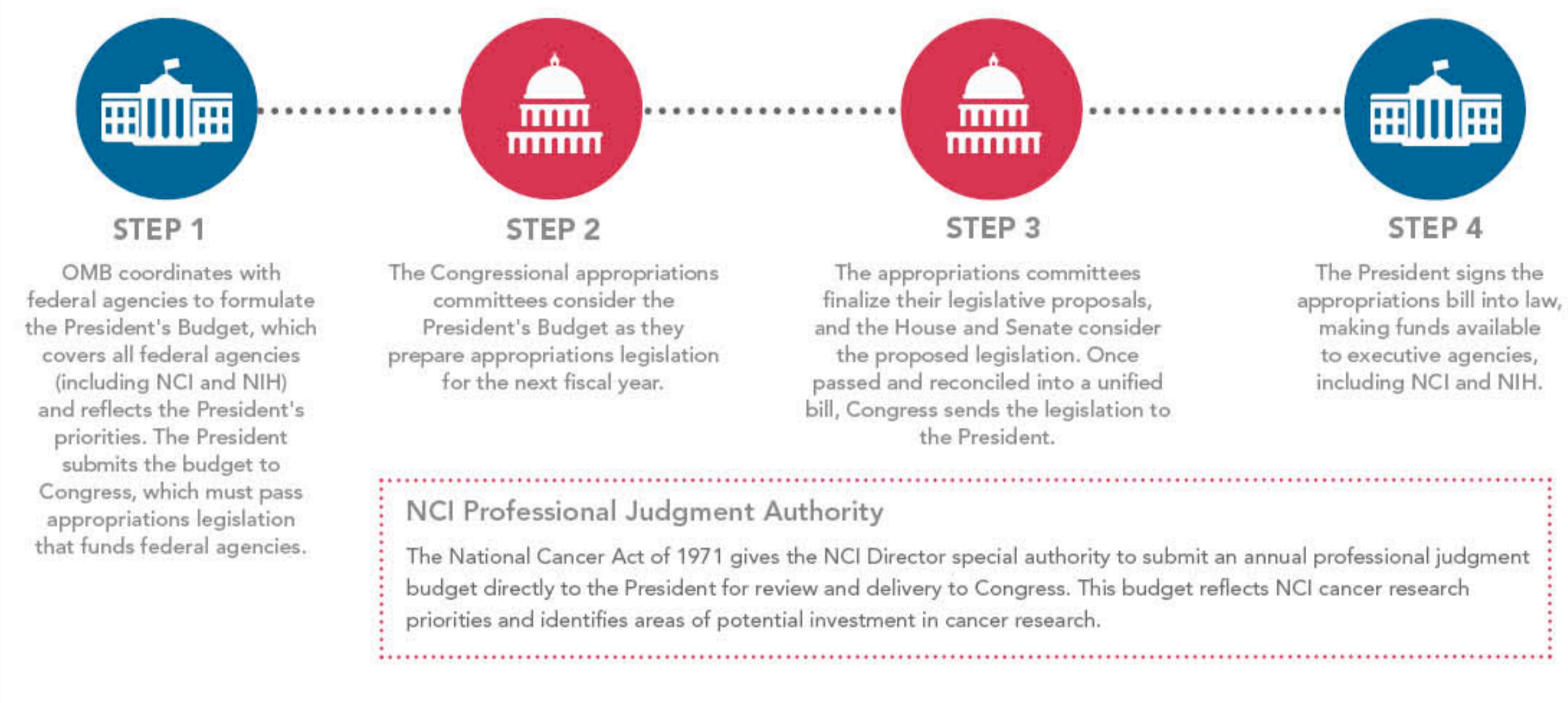

HOW NCI RECEIVES FUNDING

NCI receives its funding, or appropriation, from Congress as part of the overall federal budget process.



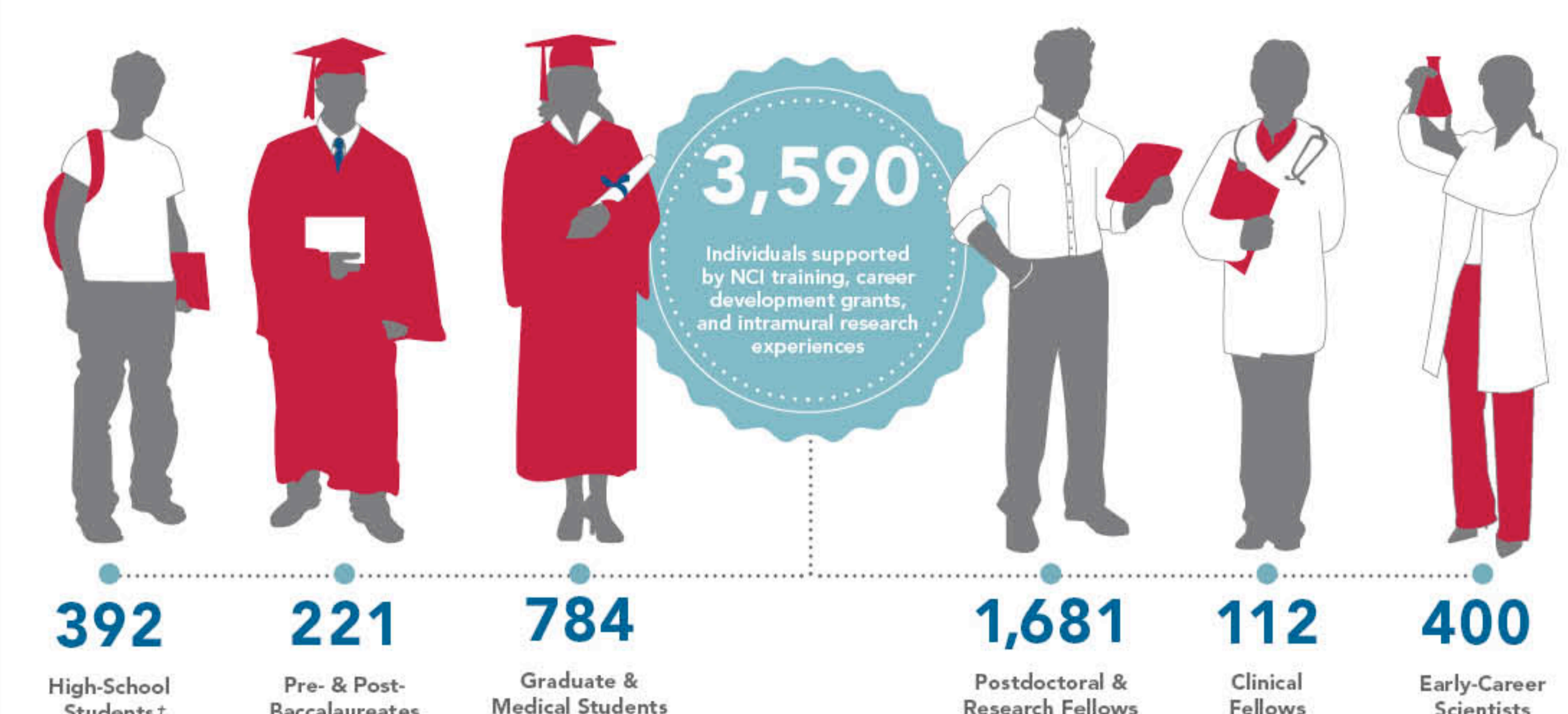
NCI-DESIGNATED CANCER CENTERS

The 68 NCI-Designated Cancer Centers are at the forefront of NCI-supported efforts at universities and cancer research centers across the United States. The centers are developing and translating scientific knowledge from promising laboratory discoveries into new treatments for cancer patients. There are 20 cancer centers, 41 comprehensive cancer centers, and 7 research centers.



TRAINING THE WORKFORCE

In FY 2013, NCI supported 3,590 emerging cancer researchers through training and career development grants and intramural research experiences.**
