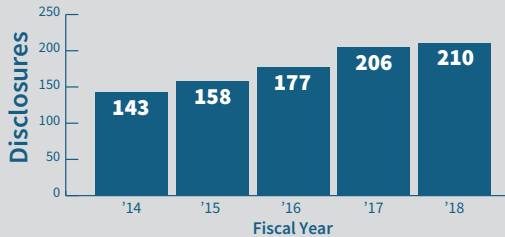

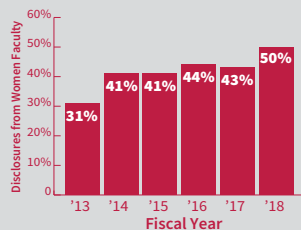

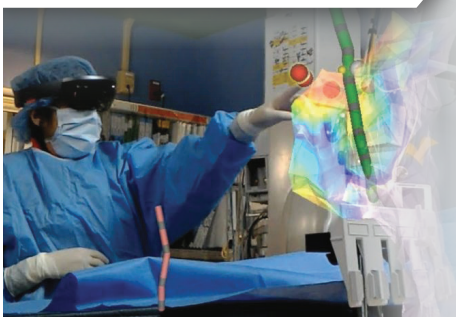

NATIONAL ACADEMY OF INVENTORS FELLOWS

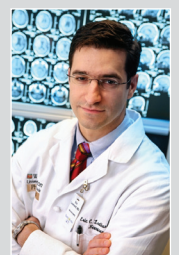
