

Healthy Volunteers Needed for Research Study on Taste

You may qualify if you

- Are over 18 years old
- Have no prior history of head/neck cancer or radiation to the head/neck
- Have no current complaints about your sense of taste

Participation involves

- Taste-testing solutions which are salty, sweet, sour, bitter, and savory
- Scratch-and-sniff smell test
- Electronic survey about your sense of taste and smell
- Testing can be completed at the **Otolaryngology Department**, or remotely via **Zoom** with supplies mailed to you
- Test appointments take up to 45 minutes and will occur 5 times over the course of 9 months
- All information collected will be kept confidential



Potential benefits:

- Participants will be compensated \$100 after completion of their last taste test.
- Contribute valuable information to help researchers understand the sense of taste and help future patients struggling with taste problems.
