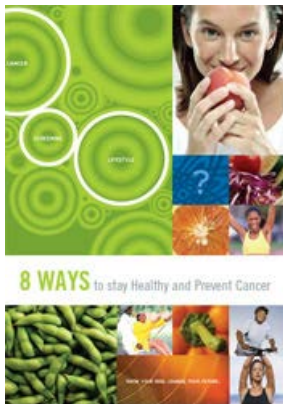




PECaD Translating 8ight Ways Materials into Two Languages
