


Installing Wacom Drivers

Step 1: go to <https://www.wacom.com/en-us/support/product-support/drivers>
Scroll down and install either the Mac or Windows driver



- How to install tablet driver**
 1. Download the driver by saving the file to any easily accessible folder.
 2. Double click "Wacom Tablet.dmg"
 3. Click Install Tablet.pkg in the automatically opened folder.
 4. Follow the Installation Wizard steps.
 5. Reboot computer
- Confirm Download** (button)
- NOTE:** Connect USB cable between tablet and USB port of your computer directly (Only Pen Tablets)

Step 2: If you are on a newer Mac OS you will get the following dialogue box after you install the driver. Click OK and then go to the apple icon on the top left corner of your screen and go to system preferences.



Open System Preferences > Security & Privacy > Privacy. Scroll to Accessibility in the list on the left. Unlock the settings, and then make sure all Wacom applications in the list are checked.


You may have to log out and back in for the changes to take effect.

OK (button)


Step 3: Click on security and privacy



Step 4: Unlock the lock at the bottom of the window. Go to privacy, then accessibility and check both drivers.




Calibrating Wacom Pen



Sometimes when you use a different Cintiq or tablet the cursor shows in a different area than where you are pointing at with your pen. If this happens, you need to calibrate your pen.

Step 1: Click on the apple icon on the top left corner of your screen, go to system preferences and click on the Wacom tablet icon.



Step 2: in the Wacom tablet window, click on the grip pen, then click on Calibration, select your Wacom device and click on calibrate.
