Players need to sign up. Share link to join private game room. Type in written answers. Simply laid out, but as of the release of this list the site is still in beta and lacks features such as choice of categories.

There are countless other multiplayer trivia

sites and mobile apps, including QuizUp, Trivia Crack and Sporcle.com.

It's assumed that for most of these games you'd run a video or voice chat service simultaneously for the best experience (e.g. Zoom, Discord). Prices mentioned are in AUD, and many games mentioned are not authorized implementations.

As said, this is not an exhaustive list, many more random sites facilitate games! To play a specific game, either research and discover if it exists online already, or get creative, and say, work out how to play it over video chat!
