

## **BACKGROUND**

Attributes are a way of organizing courses. Traditionally, attributes have been used at the school level to indicate courses that meet certain requirements. Recently we have expanded the attribute system to include departmental attributes. Departmental attributes will belong to and be managed by the department. Attributes are best used to manage large, dynamic course lists.

Attributes for A&S core requirements (Humanities, Natural Sciences & Mathematics, Social & Behavioral Sciences, and Language & Cultural Diversity) and area requirements (Writing Intensive, Applied Numeracy, and Social Differentiation) will still be approved by the A&S Curriculum Committee and be maintained by the College Office.

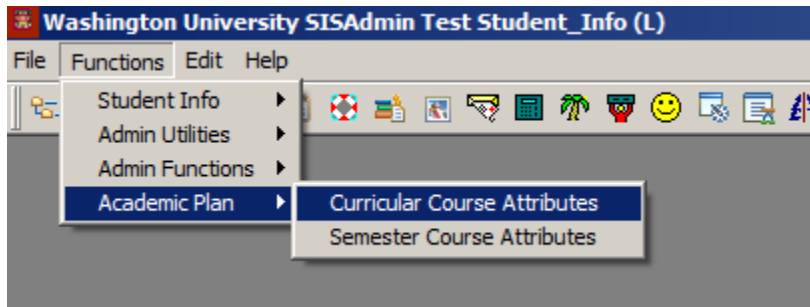

## DISCUSSION

Departmental attributes will be managed through SISAdmin using the following windows:

- 1) Functions>Academic Plan>Curricular Course Attributes
- 2) Functions>Academic Plan>Semester Course Attributes



Each semester departmental course attributes will need to be reviewed and maintained by the department administrator. Although attributes will roll forward along with courses, it will be necessary to add attributes to new courses and at times alter existing attributes. Courses will only appear in SISAdmin if they have an approved status. Once courses are approved by the Dean's Office the department administrator will need to log into SISAdmin and review the attributes.

As each participating department becomes confident with the attribute maintenance process, we will begin displaying these attributes at courses.wustl.edu. Once each department's attributes are visible online, it will be important to review them in a timely manner.

Much like courses in WUCRSL, departmental attributes must be managed at both the curriculum level and the semester level. The curriculum course attributes and the semester course attributes function independently of one another.

**NOTE:** *At both the curriculum and semester level, attributes need to be added to the home course always. An attribute added to a home course will trickle down to the idents. The opposite is not true.*

### Curriculum Level Attributes

Before an attribute is assigned to a course offered in a specific semester, that attribute should be assigned at the curriculum level. This means that any attribute a course has ever carried should appear in the curriculum. For example, if the course changes attribute designations over time because it is a topics course, the curriculum occurrence of that course should carry all possible attributes.

**NOTE:** *This is a fundamental difference with departmental attributes and core/area attributes. Core/Area attributes must remain constant from semester to semester, but departmental*

*attributes can vary semester to semester providing ease and flexibility to manage your major/minor requirements.*

Because many of our systems feed directly from semester level assignment, it is our tendency to neglect the management of curricular attributes. Because the curriculum level provides a much more comprehensive picture of your course offerings, we strongly encourage anyone using attributes to maintain them at both levels.

**Steps for adding attributes at the curriculum level (repeated with screen shots in the examples below):**

- 1) Open the Curricular Course Attributes window. Under Functions>Academic Plan.
- 2) Enter the appropriate school code (e.g. "L") and department (e.g. L32). Click Get Courses.
- 3) Click the "Approved" radio button and check the "Autosave on attribute assignment" checkbox.
- 4) On the left, find the appropriate course and click to highlight it.
- 5) Only your department's attributes should appear in the right-hand pane. Click on the appropriate attribute and drag it over to the left-hand pane.
- 6) The attribute should now appear in the listing to the left.

Semester Level Attributes

At the semester level, attributes can be added independently of other semesters or the curriculum. This is where attributes get their power. They allow departments to classify their courses based on the content that particular semester and communicate this classification to students and other systems. Over time, this will include: WUachieve, Online Course Listings, and Department Websites.

Managing attributes at the semester level is extremely important, because this is where they may be changing over time. This will need to become a part of your course listings process each semester. There are reports in WUCRSL and SISAdmin to help with this maintenance (outlined below).

**Steps for adding attributes at the semester level (repeated with screen shots in the examples below):**

- 1) Open the Semester Course Attributes window. Under Functions>Academic Plan.
- 2) Enter the appropriate semester, school code, and department. (e.g. FL2013, L, L32) Click Get Courses.
- 3) Click the "Approved" radio button.
- 4) On the left, find the appropriate course and click to highlight it.
- 5) Only your department's attributes should appear in the right-hand pane. Click on the appropriate attribute and drag it over to the left-hand pane.
- 6) The attribute should now appear in the listing to the left.

EXAMPLES

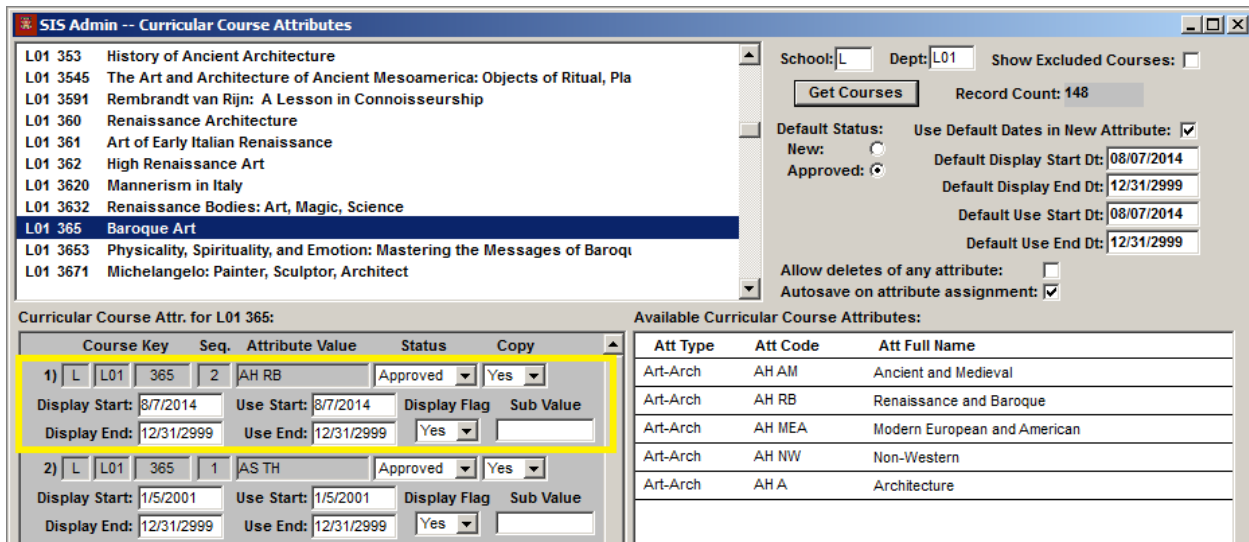
For our examples we will be using the department of Art History and Archaeology. They have a distribution requirement that states: Majors must take at least one upper-level course in three of the following five broad areas. We have assigned the following attributes.

- Ancient and Medieval (AH AM)
- Renaissance and Baroque (AH RB)
- Modern European and American (AH MEA)
- Non-western (AH NW)
- Architecture (AH A)

Example 1 (Standard Course)

L01 365, Baroque Art was offered in Fall 2010 and Fall 2011. It was home based in Art History and Archaeology and always carries the RB attributes.

- 1) The RB attribute was added at the curricular level. Steps:
  - a. Enter the appropriate school code and department. Click Get Courses. (Remember, always add attributes to the home course.)
  - b. Click the “Approved” radio button and check the “Autosave on attribute assignment” checkbox.
  - c. On the left, find the appropriate course and click to highlight it.
  - d. Only your department’s attributes should appear in the right-hand pane. Click on the appropriate attribute and drag it over to the left-hand pane.
  - e. The attribute should now appear in the listing to the left. No other steps are necessary.



- 2) The RB attributes was added for Fall 2010 at the semester level. Steps:
  - a. Enter the appropriate semester, school code, and department. Click Get Courses. (Remember, always add attributes to the home course.)
  - b. Click the “Approved” radio button.
  - c. On the left, find the appropriate course and click to highlight it.
  - d. Only your department’s attributes should appear in the right-hand pane. Click on the appropriate attribute and drag it over to the left-hand pane.
  - e. The attribute should now appear in the listing to the left. No other steps are necessary.

Example 2 (Writing Intensive Course)

L01 3001 is a writing intensive course home based in Art History and Archaeology. It was offered as an Ancient and Medieval course in Fall 2010, Fall 2011, and Fall 2012. It was offered as a Renaissance and Baroque course in Spring 2011 and Spring 2013.

- 1) It was determined that this course could potentially carry any attribute depending on the semester it was offered. All attributes were added at the curricular level.

- 2) At the semester level for Fall 2010, Fall 2011, and Fall 2012, the AM attribute was added.
- 3) At the semester level for Spring 2011 and Spring 2013 the RB attribute was added.
- 4) It will be important going forward that this course is assigned the appropriate semester attribute each time it is offered. The attribute from the prior semester will roll forward and may need to be changed.

Example 3 (Ident)

In the Fall of 2014, International and Area Studies offered L97 4224, The 1904 World’s Fair. It was cross-listed in Art History and Archaeology as L01 4224. The department decided it would carry the Modern European and American attribute.

Note: *When your department owns an attribute you can put that attribute on any course. You are not restricted to any department or school.*

- 1) Attributes should **always** be assigned to the **home** course. So the MEA attribute was added to L97 4224 at the curricular level.

Frequently Asked Questions:

**For a particular student we allowed course xxx to count towards requirement ABC. Should we add attribute ABC to course xxx?**

This is an example of an exception. Exceptions will eventually be made in the degree audit system for individual students – for example, if they are approved to take a non-AM course and have it count as an AM course. Exceptions for individual students should be few and far in-between if we get things set up correctly. An exception should never change how you enter attribute information in SISAdmin.

**Will this change how we cross-list courses? How do departmental attributes impact cross-listings?**

Nothing that we do with attributes should change how you cross-list courses. Although over time you may find a decreased need for cross-listings, your procedure for cross-listings should remain the same.
