ECONOMIC INEQUITIES



Children born into lowincome areas with fewer resources are expected to have poorer health and persistently remain in poverty than more affluent children in a zip code a few miles away.

- Median net worth of whites remains nearly 10 times the size of blacks'. Nearly 1 in 5 black families have zero or negative net worth twice the rate of white families
- Over 25% of the wealth gap is attributed to years of homeownership
- Only 34% of people who were persistently poor as children are consistently connected to work or school between the ages of 25 - 30

Following completion of summer program, students will sell books at book signingevent and promote sale of property through open house.


