

Resources for gender diverse adult patients on MO Medicaid

STL community resources

At Washington University, we are continuing to see adult patients on Missouri Medicaid for gender affirming care with no changes. At present, we do not anticipate changes with coverage of office visits and labs. The new law, implemented August 28, 2023 states that there will no longer be Missouri Medicaid coverage for gender affirming hormone therapy. We have compiled the price list below while we work internally to investigate additional possibilities for lower cost medication. Additionally, the two centers below have current systems in place for low cost medication distribution, and the funding resources provide opportunities to apply for funds to defray the cost of care.
