As an extension to our map unit, Big Bears have been talking about explorers and adventurers: Columbus, Earhart, Lindbergh, and Armstrong.

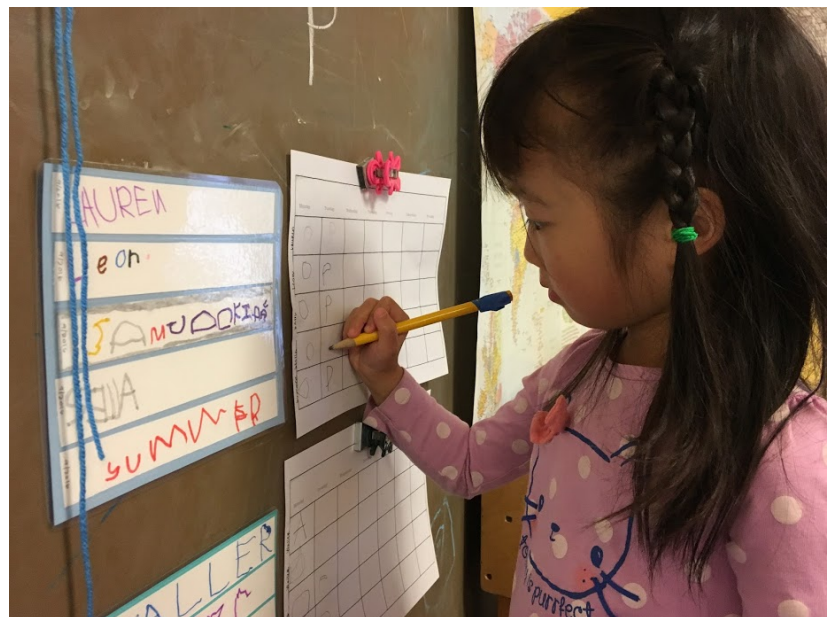
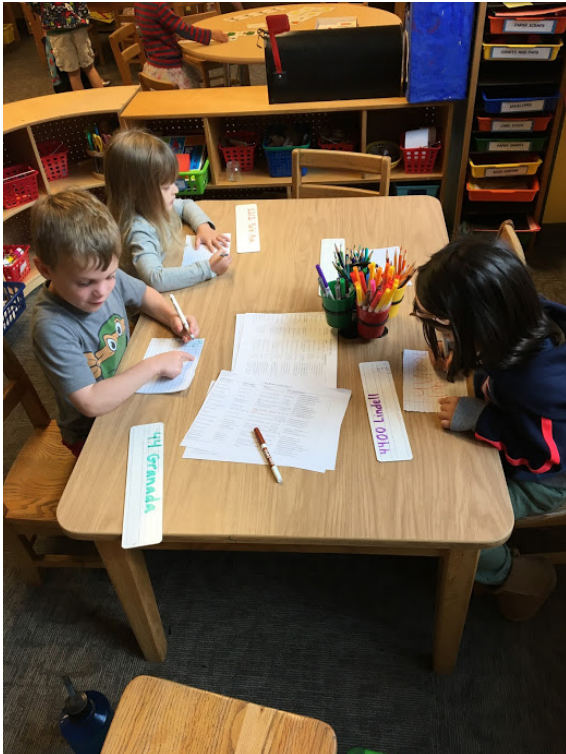
We built telescopes, looked at science books about boats, planes, and space crafts, and practiced writing words related to exploration and travel.
