Making Biscuits

Bear Cubs loved pouring, stirring, and kneading the ingredients to make biscuits. A royal treat for our little kings and queens!



Biscuit Recipe:

Preheat oven to 450
 2 cups self-rising flour
 (1 tsp baking powder if no self-rising flour)
 3 tsp sugar
 1 tsp salt.
 Mix. Add 1 and 1/3 cup heavy whipping cream.
 Mix again and knead with hands. Put batter in muffin tins. Coat with extra heavy cream after putting dough in muffin tins.
 Bake for 12 minutes at 450.
