BISCUIT RECIPE – YUMMY The children love making and eating these tasty biscuits. Please find recipe below!

We have continued to enjoy our outdoor time on the playground. The warm temperatures have allowed us to fill the trough with water and bring out the bubbles for some added fun. Many children helped with creating our big mountain of sand to represent a volcano. Many children also appreciate the challenge of making it across the monkey bars without falling into the sand, as well as going down the fire pole without assistance.

Heat oven to 450'

2 cups flour

- 1 1/3 cup whipping cream
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2-3 tablespoon sugar

Mix all ingredients together in a medium size bowl. Have flour nearby if too sticky. Knead dough until smooth. Roll out on cutting board. Use a circular cookie cutter shape to cut out biscuits. Spray a cookie sheet with Pam before placing cut biscuits on the sheet. Paint top of biscuits with additional whipping cream before baking. Cook for 11-12 minutes Enjoy cooled biscuits with honey or jam!
