

This lesson introduces the words mariposa (butterfly) and flor (flower), and re-introduces the colors in Spanish.

Mariposa, mariposa,	(Butterfly, butterfly)
Donde estas?	(Where are you?)
Aqui estoy.	(Here I am.)
Vuela, vuela, vuela,	(Fly, fly, fly)
Vuela, vuela, vuela,	(Fly, fly, fly)
Aqui estoy.	(Here I am.)

For the lesson, the teacher hands out different color cutouts of flowers. The children set their flowers in front of them in the circle. Each child gets a turn with the paper butterfly. S/he “flies” the butterfly and settles at the end of the song on a friend’s flower. The child whose flower the butterfly has landed on answers, in Spanish, the question, “Que color es tu flor?” (What color is your flower?)
