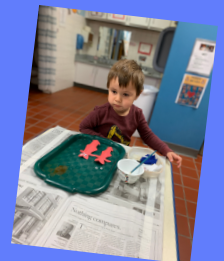
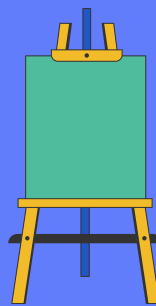
WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE A FRIEND?

PICTURES OF THEIR TEDDY BEAR FRIENDS.

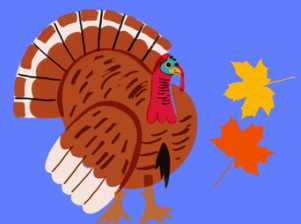
THE TEDDIES PARTICIPATED IN A COOPERATIVE
