Dear Seed Industry Colleague:

Enclosed are registration materials for the 2024-2025 Ohio Wheat Performance Trials. Commercially available and experimental varieties can be entered in the trial and will be evaluated at five locations in Ohio. Yields are reported for each location individually as the current, two, and three-year mean. Yield for all five locations in Ohio combined are reported similarly.

We would like to include seed treatment as part of the 2024-2025 report. **Please include seed treatment on the entry form, as well as on the bag of seed itself.**

Please also include seeds/lb on the entry form if it is known. This helps us plan ahead the planting rates for each variety.

NEW FOR 2024-2025:

- The Darke County location is TBD. We are looking for a new site in the area, with Clark County being a backup location if needed.
- A pre-harvest sprouting trial began with the 2021 season, conducted by the USDA ARS Quality Lab in Wooster. 
The attached guideline sheet explains each item in the order they presented on the registration form. Entrants must supply twenty (20) pounds of seed for each variety that is entered in the trials. Treated seed is preferred. Pricing is unchanged from 2011 at \$550 per entry.
