What is the Carbon Market?

The burning of fossil fuels for transportation, manufacturing, and industrial processes emits carbon dioxide into the atmosphere. Entities who are required by law to limit or offset their carbon dioxide emissions, as well as entities that are voluntarily offsetting their emissions, may purchase carbon credits that are generated from growing forests. As trees grow, they use photosynthesis to convert carbon dioxide from the air into wood. This process can be measured and values can be assigned in the form of carbon credits. Carbon credits can then be purchased by entities to help them reach their emission reduction goals. 1 carbon credit equals 1 metric tonne of carbon dioxide removed from the atmosphere.

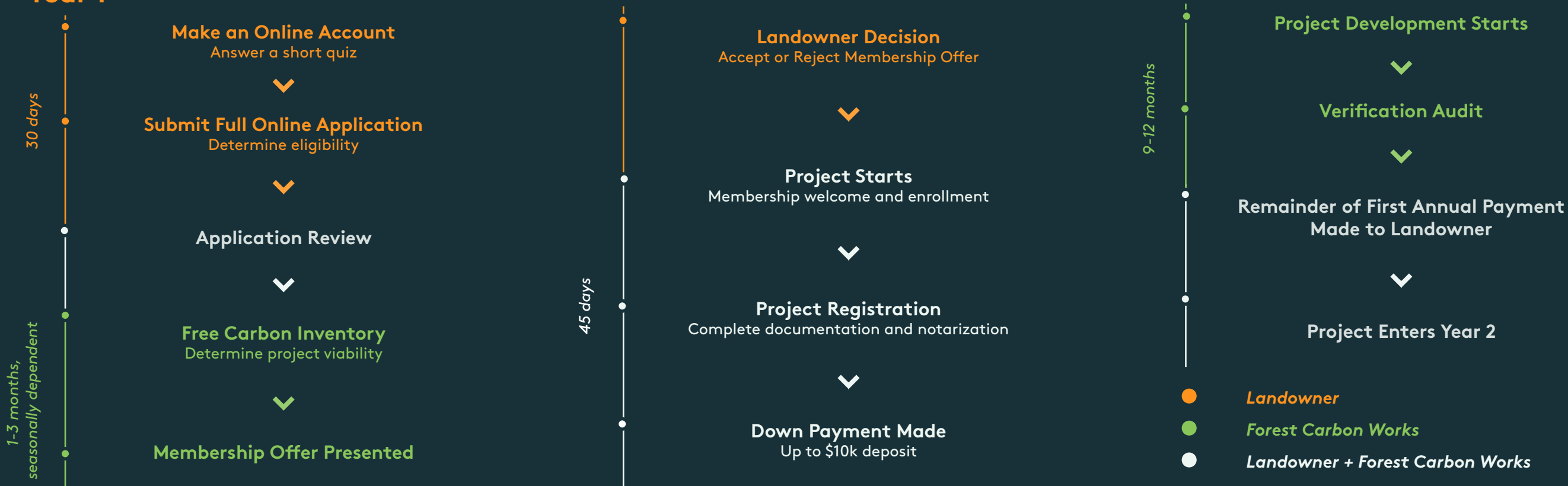
Referral Compensation

Requirements and Commitments

If you accept a Membership Offer from Forest Carbon Works, you agree to certain short-term and long-term commitments. When you enter the initial 6-year Membership Period with Forest Carbon Works, you also enter a 125-year contract with the State of California. Even if you do not continue with Forest Carbon Works beyond the initial 6-year Membership Period, you must continue to maintain the carbon project under the California guidelines. Although it is highly discouraged, the carbon project may conceivably be terminated through a high-cost penalty. Forest Carbon Works conducts a thorough due diligence process prior to executing the Membership Agreement to ensure that Members are unlikely to terminate a carbon project.

Timeline Forest carbon projects last a minimum of 125 years. This includes the following:

A 25-year Crediting Period

- Required by the State of California
- Renewable in 25-year increments
- Annual Payments to the Member are made throughout this time
- Periodic rigorous verifications (third-party audits) must be carried out
- 6-year renewable Membership Agreements with Forest Carbon Works are carried out during this time. All carbon project related activities, including verifications and sale of carbon credits, are managed by Forest Carbon Works on behalf of the Member

A 100-year Monitoring Period

- Required by the State of California
- Must be enacted immediately following the end of the most recent 25-year Crediting Period
- No Annual Payments to the Member are made throughout this time
- Periodic rigorous verifications (third-party audits) must be carried out
- All monitoring and reporting activities and costs are covered by Forest Carbon Works through the Long-term Monitoring Trust
- Harvest restrictions are lessened, often substantially, as compared with the 25-year Crediting Period

How do you know if your forest is qualified?

To be eligible for Forest Carbon Works Membership, the following must be true:

- Your forest is in the United States (in the lower 48 or southeast Alaska)
- Your forest is privately owned (not federal/state/municipal forest or forest held under federal easement)
- The total forest area is at least 40 acres
- All local, state, and federal laws are followed, including payment of property taxes
- All forest owners agree to develop a forest carbon project on the forest
- You do not lease the timber rights of the forest
- You have disclosed all harvests that have occurred within the past 10 years
- Commercial harvesting is legally allowed on the property but is not legally required. Certain cases may be permitted
- You have not enrolled your forest in any state-administered tax programs which limit or qualify the type, timing, or volume of harvesting. Certain cases may be permitted
- Your forest is not held under conservation easement. Certain cases may be permitted depending on the restrictions of the conservation easement and when it was established
- Your forest has not been previously listed as a verified forest carbon project.
