Specimens must be displayed in a vase, glass or bottle containing water.</li> <li>○ Specimen classes include Zinnias (small &amp; large variety), Marigolds (large – 1 stem disbudded) (small – 1 spray with 3 to 5 blooms and buds), Petunias (1 spray with 3 to 5 blooms and buds), Herbs (1 stem or spray), Snapdragons (large – 1 stem) (small – 1 spray), non-flowering specimens (1 stem or spray) and All Other specimens (1 stem or spray). <p>691 – Grow Your Own Vegetables</p> <p><u>Project Can Be Repeated</u></p> <p>692 – Growing with the Seasons (\$11)</p> <p><u>Project Can Be Repeated</u></p>	<p>Age 8 &amp; in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade through age 18.</p> <p>Project Levels:</p> <p>Beginner: No experience or those who are 8 to 10 years old.</p> <p>Intermediate: Some experience or those who are 11 to 13 years old.</p>	<p>Follow and complete the Member Project Guidelines on pages 3-7 of your project book.</p> <p>Required Participation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Book &amp; Exhibit Judging</li> </ul> <p>Exhibition</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ For judging you need to exhibit four (for project 691) and five (for project 692) different kinds of vegetables attractively arranged on a 12" x 16" tray or another container. Three (for project 691) and four (for project 692) of your choices need to come from the list below. Make note that beside each vegetable is the number required to make each of your choices and any specifications.
