What is the Goldwater Scholarship?

- The Barry M. Goldwater Scholarship Program encourages outstanding students to pursue careers in mathematics, the natural sciences, or engineering and to foster excellence in those fields.
- Up to 250 awards are given each year to current sophomores and juniors. The scholarship contributes up to \$7,500 in educational expenses (2 years for sophomores, 1 year for juniors).

Who is eligible to apply?

- U.S. citizens, nationals, or permanent residents.
- Sophomores and juniors. A sophomore is a student with two years of full-time academic study remaining (a junior has one year) as of Sept. 2018.
- Students of science, technology, engineering, and/or mathematics disciplines planning to pursue a PhD in their field.
- **Students pursuing an MD or other medical degree are generally NOT eligible.** Students planning to enter research via an MD/PhD are eligible.
- Must hold a competitive GPA (minimum 3.8).
- Must have significant research experience.
