

Portage County 4-H Life Skills Committee Rules for 2022 Silent Basket Auction

1. A 4-H Club must have at least one member in a Life Skills project in order to participate in the 2022 Silent Basket Auction. The club gets 50 percent of proceeds of its first basket and the remainder goes to the Life Skills scholarship fund.
2. If a club donates a second basket, 100 percent of proceeds goes to the Life Skills scholarship fund.
3. Maximum two baskets per club. Club participation in the silent basket auction is optional.
4. If an individual not associated with a club donates a basket, 100 percent of proceeds goes to the scholarship fund.
5. The club name must be attached to the basket.
6. A description of the basket's contents is to be attached to the basket.
7. Baskets will be received between 11 a.m. and noon on Sunday of Fair in the H Building. The basket must be identified as a club basket or a scholarship basket when delivered to the H Building.
8. Baskets will be displayed in the H Building on Sunday of fair. Bidders will place their bids on a bid sheet in front of the basket. Bidding begins at 2 p.m. and ends 30 minutes after the conclusion of the Life Skills Committee Bake Sale Auction. At that time, the winning bids will be announced and the winning bidders will take their baskets.
9. A booth promoting the baskets will be in the Hubbard Building. A photo presentation of each basket's contents will be displayed in the Hubbard Building booth.
