What is Operations Research?

- Operations Research (OR) is a discipline that uses **mathematics**, **statistics**, and **computer science** to help make better decisions.
- The primary goal of OR is to **optimize performance**.
 - Studying – minimize time and maximize exam score.
 - Google Maps – minimize travel time from home to school.
 - Buying an airplane ticket – minimize cost, travel time and ensure arrival at your desired time.

- **Optimization algorithm** is the process where we train the model iteratively that results in a maximum and minimum function evaluation.
 - Gradient Descent and Stochastic Gradient Descent Algorithms.
- **Hyperparameter Tuning** as Optimization.
 - Bayesian Optimization.
- **Model selection** as optimization.
