 - * My horse is misbehaving in a class - how much correction can I do without getting penalized?
 - * What little tricks could I do in a pattern class to pick up extra points?
 - * I have finished my pattern - should I look back at the judge to show respect?
 - * Can I use a tie down on my English horse? What about my Western horse?
