

HARDIN COUNTY SHEEP IMPROVEMENT ASSOC. 2014 SCHOLARSHIP

The HCSIA will award one \$500 scholarship.

Criteria

- Applicant must have had a sheep project and shown at the fair.
- Applicant must be enrolled in an accredited college for the 2014-2015 school year.
- Applicant and parent/guardian must be residents of Hardin County prior to entering college.
- Applicant must be maintaining a 2.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

Method of Application

- Application forms will be made available from the high school guidance counselor or by contacting the O.S.U. Extension office at 419-674-2297.
- *Applications must be delivered by February 21, 2014 to the Extension Office 1021 W. Lima St. Suite 103, Kenton 43326.*
- Official transcript of high school or college grades must be submitted with application.
- Applicant must include 2 letters of recommendation with application.

Selection Process

- Committee will consist of 1 Officer and 2 Board Members
- Committee reserves the right to interview all applicants, if needed, after reviewing all applications.
- Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced at the Sheep Banquet on March 1, 2014.

Method of Distribution

- Scholarship award(s) will be paid in one lump sum.
- A copy of the first semester or quarter fees which you will receive from the school that you are going to attend should be sent or delivered to:

- You will receive a check for your scholarship. It will be mailed directly to you and will be made out to the school which you are attending. Take the check to the Financial Aid or Bursar's office of the school which you plan to attend or submit it with your college bill.
- Check must be used within 6 months or money will be returned back to the scholarship fund.
