2014 HARDIN COUNTY PRINCESS OF BEEF GUIDELINES

1. Contestants must be unmarried and not in the family way, age 12 to 15, inclusive, as of January 1, 2014.
2. The contestant must live on a farm where beef cattle or beef are produced, or her parents must derive part of their income from the production of beef cattle or beef, or she must have a beef project in 4-H or FFA.
3. Contestants must participate in the Hardin County Junior Fair.
4. Contestants will be judged on the basis of her knowledge of retail cuts of beef and beef cooking procedures, and her knowledge of the beef industry, personality, poise, grooming, speech, and the content of the essay, her ability to express herself orally, church, school, 4-H, FFA and other activities.
5. Contestants must submit an essay on the subject: ***“Healthy Beef”***. Limit the length of the essay to one page, one sided. The essay may be presented orally to the Banquet audience. Candidates may also have to answer an impromptu question in front of the banquet audience.
6. The contest will be held at the Beef Banquet on Saturday, March 22, 2014, at 6:00 pm, at Hardin County Community Building, Fairgrounds. Contestants need to be at the Community Building at the Fairgrounds for Judging and Workshop by 3:30 pm on March 22, 2014, unless otherwise notified by the Queen Committee.
7. County deadline for entries is Tuesday, March 11, 2014.
8. The contestant or their parents must be members of the Hardin County Cattle Producers at the time of entry deadline.
9. Scoring: Suggested relative values offered are:

Knowledge of Beef	30 points ~	Cookery, nutrition, industry
Personality	15 points ~	Be natural, smile, look at judges
Personal Appearance	15 points ~	Poise, posture, grooming
Speech	10 points ~	Ability to express herself & answer questions
Suitability of Clothing	5 points ~	Appropriate style, color coordinated, neat
Activities	10 points ~	
Essay	15 points ~	Content and originality
