OHIO BEEF CATTLE FEEDING SCHOOL

This years Cattle Feeding School will focus on feeding alternative feeds and cost of production for fed cattle in 2025.

What is the outlook for feeding beef cattle in this cattle cycle? Garth Ruff, Beef Cattle Field Specialist will cover how the beef supply looks for the coming year and what goals with regards to quality has the industry set for itself on the long term. Risk management and budgets will be part of the discussion.

The OSU Farm business analysis team will be on hand to discuss benchmarking and long term farm financial planning.
