Q - When should I start my qualitative coursework?

ASAP, but you will often need literature from content courses to design a problem statement.

Q - Can I take two qualitative courses at once?

Yes!

Q - Can I take Life History Interviewing as an introductory OR advanced course?

Yes! The course is appropriate as either an introductory or advanced course. Please consult Dr. Errante for more information.

Q - Can I take qualitative coursework outside of EHE?

Yes, but we prefer you take at least one in EHE; many outside of EHE coming to our college for their courses because we have such talented faculty.
