FAQs

- Q When should I start my qualitative coursework?
 - ASAP, but you will often need literature from content courses to design a problem statement.
- Q Can I take two qualitative courses at once?
 - Yes!
- Q Can I take Life History Interviewing as an introductory OR advanced course?
 - Yes! The course is appropriate as either an introductory or advanced course. Please consult Dr. Errante for more information.
- Q Can I take qualitative coursework outside of EHE?
 - Yes, but we prefer you take at least one in EHE; many outside of EHE coming to *our college* for their courses because we have such talented faculty.
