

Working Group Report & Presentation

Each Student Delegate will be assigned to one of four Working Groups focused on an important topic facing industry leaders in the bioeconomy.

Working Groups will begin meeting in May in online meetings, will meet in person at BIO World Congress, and will continue meeting and conducting work through the second semester.

Working groups will produce a report and presentation detailing the research they conducted on their topic, their findings based on that research, and their recommendations. Each Working Group will have facilitators to give them direction in their specific area of work.

Expectations and Timeline:

- **August 30, 2019:** Working Groups will develop a planning, research and writing schedule and submit it to their advisors.
- **November 14, 2019:** Working Groups will submit an outline of their written report to their advisors.
- **May 2019 to February 2020:** Working Groups will meet regularly, conduct research, communicate progress to facilitators, and draft/edit report.
- **March 20, 2020:** Working Groups will submit a CLEAN draft of their report to be printed for the CABLE Spring Conference.
- **April, 2020 (exact date TBD):** Working Groups will present their research and findings during the CABLE Spring Conference. Presentations are to be 30 minutes long, with an additional 15 minutes scheduled for audience questions.
- **April 30, 2020:** Working Groups will update their reports based on feedback during their presentation, and submit their FINAL report to be printed and submitted to USDA.
