



# FRANKLIN COUNTY AGRICULTURE IN THE CLASSROOM GRANT

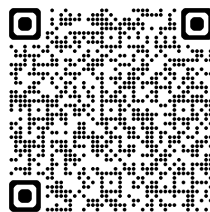

- **Nutrition education**

**Priority will be given to economically disadvantaged schools and schools that engage students with challenges or disabilities in Franklin County.**
