Watts Family Farm

Phil Watts began farming in the 1970's with 70 acres. Since then the farm has expanded to 2,500 acres and 2,000 head of cattle on feed. The expansion has happened while maintaining itself as a true family farm. You will see the top notch facilities and equipment needed to successfully operate this farm and learn about the management needed to make the operation profitable. Timbuk Farms

Hidden from the road and nestled within a picturesque Christmas tree farm is a greenhouse facility unlike anything you would imagine. You may think of Timbuk as a Christmas tree farm but it is so much more. See ten acres under roof of greenhouse structures including state of the art equipment. Use of technology has allowed Timbuk to become one of the nation's leaders in flowering plants. Our tour will end here with a treat from Velvet Ice Cream.
