Beef Breeding

Junior Heifer Calf – Calved starting January 1, 2023 thru April 1, 2023

Senior Heifer Calf – Calved between September 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022

Summer Yearling - Calved between May 1, 2022 and August 31, 2022

Junior Yearling – Calved between January 1, 2022 and April 31, 2022

Senior Yearling – Calved between September 1, 2021 and December 31, 2021

Possession Date for All Beef Breeding Projects: April 1, 2023

Market Beef

Steers – Calved after December 1, 2021; Minimum weight of 750 lbs.; Tagging Date: December 3, 2022

Beef Feeder Calves – Recommended calve dates between December 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023; Weights must be between 350 and 700 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Junior Beef Feeder Calf – Calved between February 1, 2023 and April 1, 2023; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Dairy Beef

Market

Dairy Beef Feeder – Recommended calve dates between December 1, 2022 thru January 31, 2023; Weights must be between 350 and 700 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Junior Dairy Steer - Calved February 1, 2023 thru April 1, 2023; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Dairy Steers – Calved November 1, 2021 thru January 1, 2022; Minimum weight of 850 lbs.; Tagging Date: December 3, 2022

Dairy Cattle

Junior Heifer Calf – Calved on or After March 1, 2023 thru April 1, 2023

Intermediate Heifer Calf – Calved December 1, 2022 thru Feb. 28, 2023

Senior Heifer Calf – Calved Sep 1, 2022 thru Nov 30, 2022

Junior Yearling – Calved March 1, 2022 thru August 31, 2022





Senior Yearling – Calved Sep 1, 2021 thru Feb. 28, 2022

2 Year-Old Cow – Fresh thru August 31, 2021

3 to 5 Year Old Cow - Calved September 1, 2018 thru August 31, 2020

Dry Cow – Cow 3 years old and up

Herd Class – 3 females; one 2 years or older

Producer of Dam-Two animals male or female any age Example: Mother and her daughter, a mother and her son.

Possession Date for All Dairy Cattle Projects: April 1, 2023

Goats

Breeding

Junior Dairy Kid – a doe kidded on or after April 1, 2023

Senior Dairy Kid – a doe kidded between January 1, 2023 and March 31, 2023

Dairy Wether Kid – a dairy wether goat kidded on or after December 15, 2022

Dry Yearling – a doe not in milk and kidded between June 14, 2021 and June 13, 2023

Doe 1-2 years in milk – A doe kidded between June 14, 2021 and June 13, 2022 and in milk

Doe 2-3 years in milk – A doe kidded between June 14, 2020 and June 13, 2021 and in milk **New Class**

Doe 3-4 years in milk – A doe kidded between June 14, 2019 and June 13, 2020 and in milk

Doe 4-5 years in milk – A doe kidded between June 14, 2018 and June 13, 2019 and in milk **New Class**

Doe 5 years and over in milk - A doe kidded on or before June 13, 2018 and in milk

Pygmy Goat – Kidded on or before March 13, 2023

Pet Goat – Any breed of goat and any age. Can only show in this class and will not sell. Once a goat shows in this class, it may only be shown in this class in future years.

Possession Date for All Breeding Goat Projects: April 1, 2023. Exception to this rule is the Junior Dairy Kid which has a born on date after this possession date.

Market

Market Goat: A wether or doe with a recommended kidded date between October 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023; Minimum weight of 50 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023





Dairy Market Goat: A 100% dairy breed, wether or doe, with a recommended kidded date between October 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023; Minimum weight of 50 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Sheep

Breeding - Purebred (All)

Ewe Lamb – Lambed on or after September 1, 2022

Yearling Ewe – Lambed September 1, 2021 and August 31, 2022

Aged Lamb – Lambed on or before August 31, 2021

Ram Lamb – Lambed on or after September 1, 2019

Yearling Ram – Lambed September 1, 2021 and August 31, 2022

Aged Ram – Lambed on or before August 31, 2021

Possession Date for All Purebred Breeding Sheep Projects: April 1, 2023

Breeding – Commercial/Crossbred

Junior Ewe - Lambed July 1, 2022 thru January 31, 2023

Intermediate Ewe – Lambed February 1, 2022 thru June 30, 2022

Senior Ewe – Lambed March 1, 2021 thru January 31, 2022

Possession Date for All Commercial/Crossbred Breeding Sheep Projects: April 1, 2023

Market

Recommended lambing dates between December 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022; Minimum weight of 95 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Swine

Recommended farrow dates between October 16, 2022 and January 1, 2023; Minimum weight of 190 lbs.; Tagging Date: April 1, 2023

Chickens

Exhibition

Pullets – hatched on or after June 14, 2022

Cockerels – Hatched on or after June 14, 2022

Hens – Hatched on or before June 13, 2022







Cocks - Hatched on or before June 13, 2022

Pullet Egg Laying Class – 2 pullets beginning egg production; Hatched June 14, 2022 thru February 13, 2023

Commercial Hen Egg Laying Class - 2 hens in egg production; Hatched on or before June 13, 2022

Market

Chicken Meat Pen of 3 (same sex) – Hatched April 24, 2023; Minimum weight of 3.5 lbs. per bird.

Market Chicken orders can be placed through the OSU Extension Office. Details on ordering will be sent out in January 2023. Orders will be due March 10, 2023.

Turkeys

Market

Meat Pen of Two Hens – Hatched between January 24, 2023 and February 7, 2023; Minimum weight of 20 lbs. per hen

Tom Turkeys – Hatched between January 24, 2023 and February 7, 2023; Minimum weight of 40 lbs.

Market Turkey orders can be placed through the OSU Extension Office. Details on ordering will be sent out in November 2022. Orders will be due December 21, 2022.

Hen – Hatched between June 13, 2022 and June 12, 2023

Drake – Hatched between June 13, 2022 and June 12, 2023

Aged Hen – Hatched on or before June 12, 2022

Aged Drake – Hatched on or before June 12, 2022

Duck Meat Pen of Two (same sex) – Hatched April 24, 2023; Minimum weight of 5 lbs. per bird

Hen – Hatched between June 13, 2022 and June 12, 2023







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Gander - Hatched between June 13, 2022 and June 12, 2023

Aged Hen – Hatched on or before June 12, 2022

Aged Gander – Hatched on or before June 12, 2022

Meat Pen of Two (same sex) – Hatched between March 6, 2023 and March 20, 2023; Minimum weight of 10 lbs. per bird

Peacocks

Possession Date for All Peafowl Projects: April 1, 2023

Rabbits

Breeding

Junior Buck or Doe (4 or 6 class) – Buck or Doe kindled on or after December 14, 2022

Intermediate Buck or Doe (6 class only) – Buck or Doe kindled between October 14, 2022 and December 13, 2022

Senior Buck or Doe (4 or 6 class) – Buck or Doe kindled on or before October 13, 2022

Doe and Litter Class – Doe of any age that has kits that have been kindled between May 2, 2023 and May 19, 2023. Must exhibit and show both Doe and Litter in this class.

Market

Single Fryer – Must be kindled between March 20, 2023 and April 3, 2023; Minimum Weight of 3.5 lbs.; Maximum Weight of 5.5 lbs. Possession and Tattooing Date: May 17, 2023

Meat Pen of 3 (same breed) – Must be kindled between March 20, 2023 and April 3, 2023; Minimum Weight of 3.5 lbs.; Maximum Weight of 5.5 lbs.; Possession and Tattooing Date: May 17, 2023

Roaster – Must be kindled between December 13, 2022 and March 19, 2023; Minimum Weight of 5.5 lbs.; Maximum Weight of 9 lbs.; Tattooing Dates: May 17,
