Paulding County 2023 Agricultural Scholarship

This yearly scholarship (approximately \$200) is funded with interest from a \$5000 gift in November of 1995 from the Paulding County Agronomy Committee, Inc. to the Paulding County 4-H and Youth Endowment Fund.

Guidelines:

- 1. Applicant must be a 2023 graduating senior or high school graduate of any Paulding County School or a previous recipient of this scholarship in good standing.
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled in an Ohio-based college in the pursuit of a degree in agriculture or an agricultural-related field.
- 3. The funds may be used for tuition, books, or lab fees and will be made payable to the recipient or the school. Receipts are required if funds are made to the recipient.
- 4. Applicant must have a high school GPA of at least 2.5 or a college GPA of at least 2.0.
- 5. All Applications must be physically mailed and are **due** to the Paulding County Extension Office by May 15, 2023. *Postmarked applications of May 15th will be accepted.*

Procedure:

Please submit the following information to the Paulding County Extension Office in a typed format.

- Cover Letter please include your name, address, phone number, email, and school attendance.
- 2. A written essay talking about your plans for the future and why you are pursuing an agricultural degree.
- 3. A listing of your organizational involvement within your High School (i.e., sports, FFA, newspaper club, yearbook) and outside groups (i.e., Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, VICA, DECA, 4-H, etc.)
- 4. A listing of the community service projects and long-term volunteer opportunities you have completed while in HS or College (include a short description 2-3 sentences on each community service project, the years you have completed the projects)



- 5. A listing of your top five awards or achievements while in High School or College.
- 6. Two non-family references (include name, title, email, and phone number).
- 7. High school transcript or most recent college grade report.
