	<p>The Short North Arts District is home to dozens of galleries and exhibit spaces. Less than a mile south of campus, the district plays host to Gallery Hop on the first Saturday of every month. Thousands of visitors converge on the strip to see new exhibits and to celebrate art! shortnorth.org</p>
	<p>German Village is one of the most atmospheric neighborhoods in the Midwest. Originally built by German settlers in the mid-1800s, the lovingly restored brick houses, shops, streets and sidewalks are full of historic charm and modern swank. Once you get there with a short walk or drive from downtown, the CBUS circulator or CoGo Bike Share, you'll want to explore the neighborhood on foot.</p>
	<p>Urban Arts Space, located in downtown Columbus, is 10,000 square feet of exhibition space, non-traditional performance and installation space, and conference and office space. A partnership between the Urban Arts Space and faculty from the arts and humanities allows the space to carry out its mission of teaching, experimentation and community engagement. uas.osu.edu</p>
